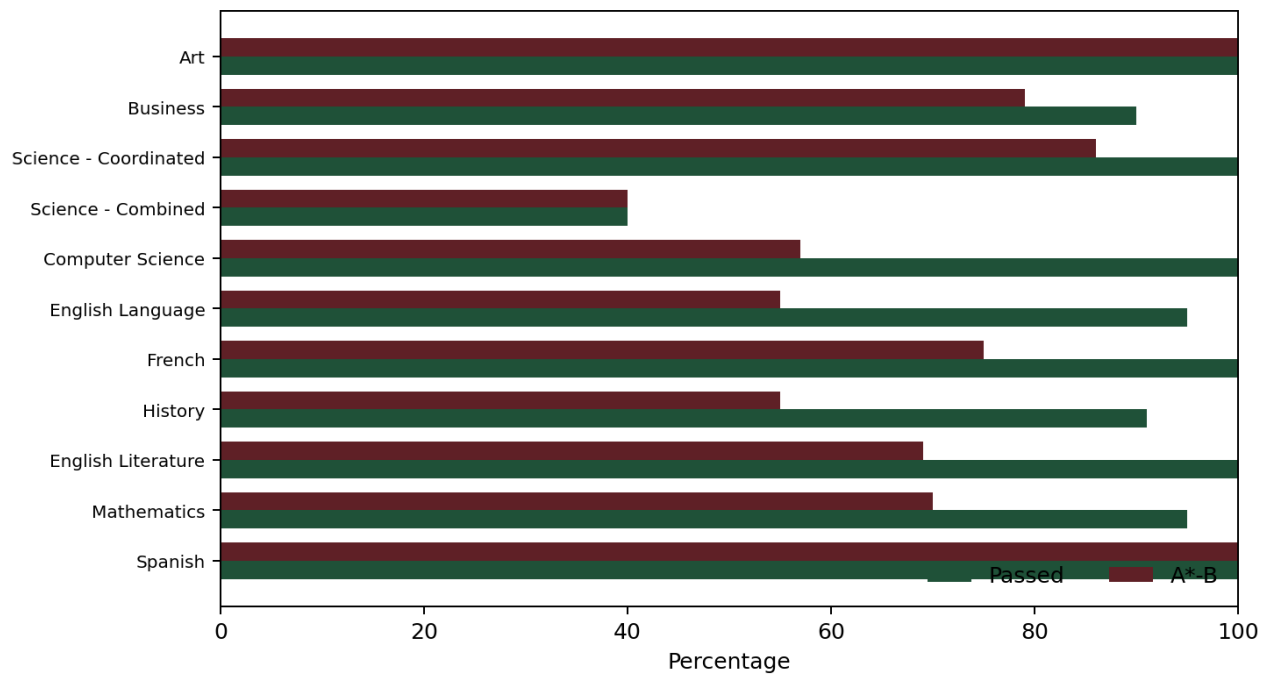

Closing perspective

Achievement with ambition for what comes next

The 2026 IGCSE results highlight the academic strength and educational quality of Dallington School. With a 100% Non-SEN pass rate for the minimum subjects required for 4° ESO equivalency, students demonstrated strong attainment across the curriculum.

More than half of all exams achieved A*/A grades. The original report also notes performance above cited UK national and Cambridge International benchmarks, alongside particularly strong outcomes for students with Special Educational Needs.

The report connects these outcomes with the school's personalised learning pathways, inclusive culture and the four-year full authorisation awarded following the NABSS inspection in February 2026.
