Processing related to compulsory schooling is legitimised by Organic Law 2/2006, of 3 May, on Education, as amended by Organic Law 8/2013, of 9 December, for the improvement of educational quality and Organic Law 3/2020, of 29 December, which amends Organic Law 2/2006, of 3 May, on Education.

**Treatment of images and videos:** in the event that it is necessary to use the image in the school's media, we will request consent at the end of this document.

We inform you that, as a general rule, families are not allowed to capture images inside our facilities. The only exception to this prohibition will be in sporting or cultural events expressly organised by the school, as in this case the recording or taking of images will be carried out within the domestic environment, and it will be the responsibility of each family member to publish, communicate or transfer to third parties.

**Communication to third parties:** academic data will be communicated to the Ministry of Education and the Regional Ministry of Education in accordance with current legislation. Data related to enrolment fees will be communicated to banking institutions. There is information that can be communicated to the Administrations, with competence in the matter, Tax Administration, Insurance Entities and public and/or private Entities for the control of student's attendance, e.g. field trips.

**International transfers:** data may be transferred to the UK for student exchanges or language certification examinations, in particular to Cambridge Assessment English, in accordance with Article 45 of the GDPR, with the guarantee of a level of data protection under an adequacy decision taken by the EU Commission.

**Special category data:** health data may be collected when providing us with information about the pupil's allergies, food intolerances, prescribed medical treatments and/or psychopedagogical evaluations, which, in some cases, will require the express consent of the parents or guardians, except in cases of urgent need in which the vital interest of the minor will operate.

**Data retention criteria:** personal data will be stored for the duration of the student's schooling. At the end of the same, the personal data processed for each of the purposes indicated will be kept for the legally established periods or for the period of time that a judge or court may require them, taking into account the statute of limitations for legal actions. The data processed on the basis of the data subject's consent shall be kept until the aforementioned legal periods expire, if there is a legal obligation to keep them, or, if there is no such legal period, until the data subject requests their deletion or revokes the consent granted. The academic record shall be kept indefinitely.

**Rights of the Stakeholder:**

- The right to withdraw consent at any time.
- The right of access, rectification, objection, erasure, portability and restriction of processing.
